1. Installation

Download Extension

- Download the extension on the website:
<https://www.tigren.com/product/magento-2-multiple-order-emails/>



Unpack Zip File

- After downloading, unpack the extension zip file



Upload Files

- Upload all the files from the extension package to the root folder of your Magento installation



Run Following Commands

- `php bin/magento module:enable Tigren_Core`
- `php bin/magento module:enable Tigren_Multipleorderemail`
- `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
- `php bin/magento cache:flush`
