Ajax Suite for Magento 2 is a collection of powerful extensions (Ajax Cart, Ajax Login, Ajax Wishlist, and Ajax Compare). It's a gateway to a world of advantages that will transform your online store.

Installation Guide

Step 1: Download the extension package

Step 2: Unpack the extension's zip file

Step 3: Upload all the extracted files from the extension package to the root folder of your Magento installation

Step 4: Run the following commands in your Magento directory:


- `php bin/magento module:enable Tigren_Core`
- `php bin/magento module:enable Tigren_Ajaxsuite`
- `php bin/magento module:enable Tigren_Ajaxcart`
- `php bin/magento module:enable Tigren_Ajaxlogin`
- `php bin/magento module:enable Tigren_Ajaxwishlist`
- `php bin/magento module:enable Tigren_Ajaxcompare`
- `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
- `php bin/magento cache:flush`

User Guide

To make the extensions in Ajax Suite work, you need to configure each one individually:


Ajax Suite

- Go to **Stores > Configuration > TIGREN > Ajax Suite**.
- Expand the **General** tab.
- Enable Ajax Suite: select **Yes** to enable the extension
- Auto Close Notification Popup: select **Yes** if you want the Ajax Cart/ Login/ Wishlist/ Compare popups will be automatically closed.
- Popup will close after: If you chose “Yes” in the previous section, you can specify the time (in second) after which the popup will close.



Since the Ajax Suite acts as the backbone for all included extensions, you can set up the design and effects of all popups in the Ajax Suite configuration.

- Expand the **Popup Design and Effects** tab.
- Choose your preferred Animation for popup display effect.
- Customize the background color, header success background color, header error background color, header text color, button text color, button background color of the popups.
- Save your settings.

Ajax Cart

- Below the Ajax Suite section, find the Ajax Cart settings.
- Select **Yes** to enable Ajax Cart features
- Enter the message that will be shown to your customers after they add products to the shopping cart.
- Customize the remaining options based on your store requirements: show cart information/ related products in the success popup, Ajax update in the shopping cart page, Ajax autoload quantity if it changes.

- Save your settings.

Ajax Login

- Below the Ajax Cart section, find the Ajax Login settings.
- Select **Yes** to enable Ajax Login features
- Choose the destination page where you want the customers to be redirected after successful login (e.g.: Customer dashboard, Home page, Cart page, Wishlist page, or stay on the current page - Reload).
- Choose the slide animation for the login popup (e.g.: Show, Fade, Slide)
- Select “Yes” if you want to enable social login feature and provide your credentials for the allowed social networks (Facebook, Twitter).
- Save your settings.

Ajax Wishlist


- Below the Ajax Login section, find the Ajax Wishlist settings.
